# Outreach Influence Team Leader Ministry Description

### **Primary Description:**

The Outreach Influence Team Leader will serve the church through helping develop outreach vision and action by partnering with key influencers and spreading the vision for Organic Outreach within the church leadership culture, each ministry of the church, the whole congregation, and ultimately mobilizing church members to share the Gospel as they scatter all over the community and world.

**Status**: Part time (8-10 hours a week on average)

**Lines of Accountability**: The Outreach Influence Team Leader will report directly to the Lead Pastor.

#### Ministry Responsibilities:

#### 1. Leadership of the Outreach Influence Team

- Lead a quarterly *Full Team Meeting* of the Outreach Influence Team
  in partnership with the Lead Pastor. This will be a time to keep leaders
  accountable for their personal and ministry outreach temperature, to
  teach new outreach concepts, to bring all ministries together around
  upcoming outreach events, and allow each individual ministry to seek
  help and support in their outreach ministry.
- Lead quarterly Outreach Clusters of strategic groups of leaders who
  are part of the Outreach Influence Team. These times are designed to
  create a space for accountability for each person's personal and
  ministry outreach temperature, for learning, for vision sharing around
  the topic of evangelism, and for strategic planning.
- Lead quarterly One-on-One Meetings with each member of the
  Outreach Influence Team. These meetings will be a time when the
  Outreach Influence Team Leader keeps team members accountable to
  be raising their outreach temperature both personally and in their
  ministry. It is also a time to offer encouragement, training, and support
  in the outreach ministry of each person on the Outreach Influence
  Team.

- Regular communication with and encouragement of OIT members through personal contact, email communication, and other forms of correspondence.
- Regular prayer for all members of the OIT and for the ministries they lead.

## 2. Support of Church Outreach Ministries

- Function in partnership with whoever leads global outreach, community outreach, or any church-wide outreach initiatives. Give encouragement to help maintain synergy between all levels of Church Outreach, Community Outreach, and World Outreach.
- Meet regularly with the Lead Pastor to make sure the direction of Church Outreach works in concert with the Church vision set by the Lead Pastor and Church board.
- Work as a partner, as needed and able, on church-wide outreach initiatives.
- Work as a partner in Community Outreach events, as able.
- Work as a partner in World Outreach efforts, as able.

**Note**: All of these responsibilities involve partnership, prayer, and encouragement, but not leadership of outreach ministries or events. This leadership comes from the ministry leaders (both staff and volunteer). The Outreach Influence Team Leader is not expected or allowed to lead the outreach ministries of the church.
