 - Story teller
 - o Good listener
 - You connect your experience to others
- Ways You Can Use This Style Organically

The Intellectual Style

- A Biblical Example (Paul) Acts 17:16-34
- A Modern Example
- What About You? Do you tend to be...
 - o Inquisitive
 - Analytical
 - o Logical
 - Like to debate (but not obnoxious)
 - Enjoy study
- Ways You Can Use This Style Organically

Interpersonal Style

- A Biblical Example (Matthew) Luke 5:27-32
- A Modern Example
- What About You? Do you tend to be...
 - Warm Personality
 - Conversational
 - o Friendship oriented
 - Tend to focus on others and their needs (more than on ideas)
- Ways You Can Use This Style Organically

Invitational Style

- A Biblical Example (Woman at the Well) John 4:4-42
- A Modern Example
- What About You? Do you tend to be...
 - o Hospitable
 - Relational
 - o Persuasive
 - o Enjoy new people
- Ways You Can Use This Style Organically

Service Style

- A Biblical Example (Dorcus) Acts 9:36-43
- A Modern Example
- What About You? Do you tend to be...
 - Others-centered
 - o Humble
 - o Patient
 - o Helpful
 - Notice needs and joyfully engage (in Jesus' name)
- Ways You Can Use This Style Organically

The Confrontational Style

- A Biblical Example (Peter) Acts 2:14-41
- A Modern Example
- What About You? Do you tend to be...
 - Confident
 - Assertive
 - o Direct
 - May not like small talk
- Ways You Can Use This Style Organically

The Prayer Style

- A Biblical Example (Paul and Silas) Acts 16:25-34
- A Modern Example
- What About You? Do you tend to be...
 - One who believes in the power of prayer
 - o Often praying for lost people
 - Comfortably praying with lost people
 - Someone people come to when they have prayer needs (even nonbelievers)
- Ways You Can Use This Style Organically
