- 3. One full year of agendas for the **full team meetings** of your Organic Outreach Influence Team (these happen once a quarter).
- 4. One full year of agendas for your **cluster groups** of your Organic Outreach Influence Team (these happen once a quarter).
- 5. One full year of agendas for your **one-on-one meetings** of your Organic Outreach Influence Team members (these happen once a quarter).
- 6. A few closing thoughts about the critical place of the Outreach Influence Team infusions and gatherings that happen every thirty days.

1. Introduction

Outreach rarely just happens. We must pray, love, be trained, and share the message of Jesus. We are called to "Always be prepared to give an account for the hope that is in us," and we are to do this with "gentleness and respect" (1 Peter 3:15). Most important, you and I have the privilege of partnering with the Holy Spirit of God who is always the first and final evangelist! We can scatter seeds and we can water, but God brings the growth (1 Corinthians 3:6).

Not only must we be intentional and relentless about bringing the love and message of Jesus to the world, but we need to recognize that the full force of hell is thrown against the work of evangelism (Ephesians 6:10-17). There will always be spiritual resistance to the work of outreach. It is a war! So, our intentionality really matters. Having a process that keeps evangelism and the gospel on the front burner of our hearts and the life of the church is essential.

This collection of free resources is designed to help you bring regular infusions of outreach inspiration, teaching, partnership, and accountability to your church every thirty days. Over the last twenty years of my study, research, leading outreach in the local church, and coaching church leaders I have learned that we must bring a clear infusion of outreach focus every month or the vision and forward momentum of outreach begins to die (for more on the "Thirty Day Rule" see pages 125-127 in *Organic Outreach for Churches*).

With this in mind, I have designed detailed Outreach Influence Team agendas with suggested resources to help you keep the fire burning hot and the momentum moving forward. Please use these as you see fit. They are all free and provided in an

downloadable version at www.KevinGHarney.com so you can edit and personalize them for your ministry context. Please feel free to add, take away, and re-organize these in ways that will best serve your church. I do ask that you keep the footer on the agendas and other resources so that all who use these can be directed to the websites that offer other free materials for Organic Outreach.

If you discover a better way to keep the evangelistic temperature burning hot in your church, please send me your ideas and I will seek to incorporate them into my work and I will pass them on to others (being careful to credit your work as yours). As you use these resources and all three of the Organic Outreach books, there are a couple of things I should clarify. One is about language and the other is about sharing.

Terminology: I use the term "Organic Outreach" interchangeably with the term "Evangelism." When I say "Organic Outreach" I am talking about the process of Christians, Churches, and Families sharing the message of Jesus in natural ways as they love, show grace, walk with people, and proclaim the life-changing message of salvation through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

My Philosophy of Sharing and Giving Away Free Stuff: Sharing the Good News of Jesus is the call of every believer and every church. We receive the gospel freely and should share freely. Sharing the Gospel is one of the most important things we will ever do. So, I do all I can to create outreach resources and give them away. You will find all sorts of free outreach tools (Teaching videos, Conversation starter videos, Articles, Outreach resources, and much more) on the following three websites:

Please feel free to use any and all of these resources and pass them on to others who are seeking to share the message of Jesus. Also, pray for other churches and ministries. If you share them with me and give me permission to do so, I will do all I can to get the great work you are doing into the hands of others.

2. How To Use These Resources

The Outreach Influence Team: This is a strategic leadership team made up of the key leader/influencer of every ministry in your church. You can learn more about the philosophy of this team and how to form your Outreach Influence Team by reading (*Organic Outreach for Churches*, chapters 5-7).

The Outreach Influence Team Leader: This is the clearly called and designated leader of outreach in your church (You will find an example ministry description for this position in the free resources on the KevinGHarney.com website). This person does **not** run programs, but commits 8-10 hours a week (as a volunteer or staff member) for the sole purpose of infusing the following things into all your key church leaders/influencers of each church ministry:

- 1. **Vision / Inspiration / Passion**: Every thirty days the Outreach Influence Team Leader will create a place where passion and fuel for outreach vision will be shared with each person on the Outreach Influence Team. We all need to be reminded, on a regular basis, of the heart of God for the lost and the call on our lives (and churches) to bring the good news to our communities and this world. We need encouragement and inspiration to keep the light of Jesus shining!
- 2. **Teaching**: Every thirty days some form of teaching, fresh information, helpful outreach ideas, new content, or a reminder of lessons already learned should be brought to your leaders. The Outreach Influence Team Leader is responsible to make sure this happens. In the following pages you will find a full year of teaching ideas, equipping videos, and content from the Organic Outreach books. This will make the teaching and learning process go very smoothly. When videos are suggested, you can use them or teach the concepts yourself after watching the videos and reading the materials provided in the Organic Outreach books.
- 3. **Strategic Partnerships**: Church leaders need to move in unison and operate in concert if we are going to truly impact our community and share the good news of Jesus. This means that the Outreach Influence Team Leader will need to help build bridges of communication between your church ministry leaders and help them work as a team. When we partner on all-church events and support each other on departmental outreach efforts, the whole church moves forward together. In addition, we should do all we can to support and work with other Christian churches in our community as we all reach out with the Gospel of Jesus.
- 4. **Accountability**: Every thirty days the Outreach Influence Team Leader will connect with every key leader in your church (in a full team meeting, strategic cluster, or one-on-one meeting). In this time the Outreach Influence Team Leader will keep them accountable for their personal outreach, their ministry outreach, for sharing the outreach vision with all those who are part of their ministry team, and for working in partnership as an Outreach

Influence Team. Without consistent and clear accountability, outreach tends to slow and eventually stop.

3. Full Outreach Influence Team Agendas (Year One)

Introduction: Elements of a Full OIT Meeting (1.5 hour gathering)

The quarterly OIT full team meeting follows a simple format with creativity and innovation infused by the Outreach Influence Team Leader.

Advanced Preparation: There are resources provided for each Outreach Influence Team Member to prepare for all team meetings. First, there is *reading*. It is critical that all team members take time to study this content. If they do, the concepts will come alive and the team meeting will be dynamic with discussion and learning. There is also *prayer* direction. In addition, there is always some *action* suggestion. If all team members take this preparation seriously, it will accelerate the learning process for the team and the evangelistic fruitfulness of your church.

Opening Prayer and Devotion: The OIT Leader or a designated team member will share a biblical passage and some reflections about how this passage should direct or inspire our Organic Outreach lifestyle and leadership.

Outreach Learning: The Outreach Influence Team Leader will also lead a time of learning around an outreach concept or practice. This will include some teaching and training, but also mutual learning as they invite all of the team members to share what they are learning or know about this topic. Some of this teaching is based on videos provided free at www.OrganicOutreach.com and www.KevinGHarney.com. Feel free to use these or do the teaching yourself...whatever works best for you.

A Minute to Share It (or 2-3 minutes): Each team member will give their personal outreach temperature (see OOOP chapter 4 and OOC chapter 7) and also their ministry outreach temperature. They will also share one way they are seeking to raise their temperature (personal or ministry) by one degree. If they have a great organic outreach testimony they can take an extra sixty seconds. (Note: Many churches use an egg timer to make sure they stay on schedule. As the vision for outreach grows and more of your team members are living outreach, this sharing time can last the full hour and a half. This does not leave time for the rest of the elements of the full team gathering that are very important. So, watch your time on this).

Group Discussion and Collaboration: Each time your group meets you will talk about church-wide outreach collaboration on two levels...

• *All Church Events*: The Outreach Team Leader will ask what outreach events or opportunities are coming up in the next six months that relate to the whole church? Who is leading this event (what ministry owns it)? How can

each of the church ministries support, participate, and fully engage as partners?

• *Ministry Based Outreach*: They will also ask, what outreach activity, ministry, or event is coming up in your specific area of ministry? How can the rest of our ministries pray, encourage, or support you in your outreach efforts?

Preparation: There is always some sort of preparation for the next meeting. The OIT leader will encourage each member of the team to prepare by reading, reflecting, or whatever is assigned for the next meeting.

Closing Prayer: Every full team meeting is closed with a time where the church leaders raise their voices and hearts together in prayer. Thank God for the great things he is doing. Ask for His presence and power. Pray for upcoming outreach initiatives you are doing as a whole church and in specific ministries.

Notes:

- ✓ These full team meetings are normally held on a weekday evening because some team members can be volunteers and they often can't make daytime meetings.
- ✓ This gathering should never be a few minute add-on to an existing meeting. It must be a quarterly meeting focused entirely on Organic Outreach where all of the church influencers come together.
- ✓ Many teams build this meeting around a dinner or a nice table of snacks.
- ✓ This meeting is a high priority and everyone on the team, including the Lead Pastor, is expected to shoot for 100% attendance. Be present in body, heart, and mind.

4. Elements of an OIT Cluster Meeting (1 hour gathering)

The quarterly OIT Cluster meeting follows a simple format with creativity and innovation infused within the process. This meeting is a half hour shorter and more free flowing. With a smaller group, you can make space for more interaction and discussion. I encourage Outreach Influence Leaders to make sure they speak and teach no more than 30-40% of this time and let the rest be open for guided conversation around the cluster theme(s). It is best to have three to five people in a cluster group. And, you can have these stay the same, or mix it up.

The elements are similar to the full team meetings:

- Directions to prepare for the meeting
- Prayer
- Three Minutes to Share It (There is more time for accountability in the cluster because there are fewer people to share)
- Learning
- Collaboration

- Prayer
- Directions to prepare for the next meeting (One-on-One)

Notes:

- ✓ Cluster meetings can be held on a weekday evening because some team members can be volunteers and they often can't make daytime meetings. But, if all the members of the cluster work at the church, this meeting can happen during a workday.
- ✓ These gatherings can occasionally be around a dinner table, or you might want to have some simple snacks.
- ✓ These meetings create space for relationship building, good conversation, and for strategic planning for ministry teams.
- ✓ These meetings work well for more intimate accountability and prayer as we develop our outreach skills and ministry plans.

5. Elements of an OIT One-on-One Meeting (45 minute or 1 hour meeting)

The quarterly OIT One-on-One meeting will follows a simple format with creativity and innovation infused within the process:

- Directions to prepare for the meeting
- Praver
- Time to Share your personal and ministry temperature and how you are raising it
- Learning and Practice (There will be assignments for each team member to prepare for this time. These will often be focused on skills as well as ministry development ideas)
- Prayer
- Directions to prepare for the next meeting (Full Team)

Notes:

- ✓ One-On-One meetings can be held any time that works for the OIT Leader and member. If the two people are of the opposite sex, it is very wise to have the meeting on the church campus in a public space.
- ✓ These meetings create time for in-depth ministry conversation, and for strategic planning for specific ministry teams.

Preparing for this meeting...

Reading:

Prayer: Ask for God to mobilize every person in your church to reach out with the Gospel. Pray that God will turn the temperature of your heart up when it comes to loving lost people and reaching out with the grace of Jesus.

Personal Action: Try one of the "Organic Activities" on page 70 of *Organic Outreach* for Ordinary People.

Meeting Agenda

Meeting Focus and Learning Theme: In this full team meeting we will turn our attention to two essential themes of Organic Outreach. 1) Understanding the meaning of "Organic Outreach," and 2) The One Degree Rule (the what, why, and how of raising our outreach temperature).

Opening Prayer

- **Read**: Matthew 9:35-38
- **Prayer Focus**: For eyes to see that lost people are like sheep without a shepherd. For God to send workers out into His harvest field...starting with the members of your Outreach Influence Team and moving into your whole church.

Outreach Learning

Teaching Themes: Understanding Organic Outreach & The One-Degree Rule

Watch the "What is Organic Outreach?" Video

Notes:

Discussion:

- How can Christians be like light in our world? What does light do that we should be doing?
- How are we supposed to be like salt? What does salt do that we should be doing?
- Give an example of what it looks like when a Christian reaches out in natural and organic ways.

Watch the "Are You Washed in the Blood?" Video

Notes:

Discussion:

- Give an example of what it might look like when someone tries to reach out in a way that is not organic or natural.
- What are some of the consequences of this kind of outreach?

Watch the "The One-Degree Rule" Video

Discussion:

- What are things that can quench our passion and turn our temperature down?
- Who is one person you love and care about who is still far from Jesus?

A Minute to Share It

- What is your personal outreach temperature right now?
- What is your ministry outreach temperature right now?
- What is one way you can begin to raise your temperature in the coming week?

Group Discussion and Collaboration

What is coming up in the next six months that is church-wide (all hands on deck) outreach?

- Who is leading the event (what ministry owns it)?
- How can you work together (What will each ministry team do, how will they fully engage?)
- How can you pray for this event?

What is coming up in your specific area of ministry in the next three to six months that is focused on outreach?

- How can other ministry leaders and teams support you and help you bear great kingdom fruit?
- How can we all be praying for you?

Closing Prayer: Pray together for...

- The temperature of outreach to go up in your life, your ministry, the whole church, and in all the churches around your community and the world.
- Upcoming outreach ministries and events in your church and ministry areas.
- Outreach to be a passion ignited by the Holy Spirit and not just a church program.

Reading:

Prayer: Ask God to keep raising your outreach temperature.

Personal Action: Make a list of all the people who you see as your Level Four Leaders (Ministry workers you lead and partner with). Begin praying for God to help you influence them in their personal and ministry outreach. Please send this list to your Outreach Influence Team leader two days before your cluster meets.

Organic Outreach Influence Team Cluster Meeting (Year 1, Quarter 1) Date of Meeting

Preparing for this meeting...

Reading:

- Organic Outreach for Churches (Pages 79-94) Beyond Push Pins and Committees.
- o Organic Outreach for Churches (Pages 96-116) Six Levels of Influence.

Prayer: Ask God to ignite the hearts of the leaders in your church so that each one loves the lost with greater passion and personally engages in evangelism.

Personal Action: Be sure you send your Outreach Influence Team Leader your list of all Level Four Leaders and ministry helpers two days before your cluster meeting.

Meeting Agenda

Meeting Focus and Learning Theme: In this cluster gathering you will dig into the vision of Organic Outreach and how to move the passion and practice of evangelism into the life of an entire church or Christian organization.

Opening Prayer

• Pray for minds to understand the simple concepts of mobilizing a church for outreach and for hearts that are open to be challenged and stretched.

Three Minutes to Share It (The One-Degree Rule)

- What was your personal outreach temperature over the past month?
- Who is one person you are seeking to reach with the gospel of Jesus?
- What is your ministry outreach temperature?
- What are you doing to raise your personal or ministry outreach temperature by one degree?
- Tell one outreach story from your personal outreach or ministry area.

Outreach Learning

Teaching Themes: Beyond Push Pins and Committees to Organic Outreach and the Six-Levels of Influence.

Watch the "The Evolution of Outreach" Video

Notes:

Discussion:

- Describe the dynamics of a "Push-Pin" approach to outreach where sending money and prayers far away is the main focus. What are values of this approach and what are weaknesses?
- Describe how a "Committee" approach to outreach works. How can this approach help a church move forward with outreach? What are some of the weaknesses of this structure of outreach?
- How does Organic Outreach, where an entire church is mobilized for outreach right where God has placed them in life, create potential for great evangelistic fruitfulness?

Level 1- God

Level 2- Outreach Influence Team Leader

Level 3- Outreach Influence **Team** (This is you!)

Level 4- Ministry **Workers** (Who are your workers? Staff? Volunteers?)

Level 5- Ministry **Participants** (Who are your ministry participants?)

Level 6- The **World** (How will the world change if your ministry participants are fully engaged in outreach?)

Discussion Questions:

- Why is each level needed?
- What will move the outreach vision to the next level?
- What are some consequences if the vision and practice gets stuck at one of these levels?

• What can you do to bring the vision to Level 4 in the coming month?

Group Discussion and Collaboration

What is coming up in your area of ministry in the next three to six months that is focused on outreach and how can the people in your cluster support you and pray for you?

Closing Prayer: Pray together for...

- Your Level 2 Leader. Ask God to empower this person and lead them so they can influence your whole church and community.
- Yourself as you influence your Level 4 Leaders and servants.
- Your area of ministry to be infused with a passion for outreach and commitment to reach out.

Preparation for next month's Organic Outreach One-on-One Meeting

Reading:

Personal Action: Make a simple strategy (1-2 pages) for how you will take the vision for Organic Outreach and the skills you are learning and share them with your Level 4 Leaders. How will you do this every thirty days? You can use the agendas and tools from your full team meetings and edit/adapt them for your own setting if this would be helpful. They are all available as a free download on the websites listed on the bottom of each page.

Preparing for this meeting...

Reading:

Personal Action: Review your written strategy (1-2 pages) of how you will be bringing the vision and skills of Organic Outreach to your Level 4 Leaders in the coming year. Be ready to share this with your OIT leader.

- Who is one person you are seeking to reach with the gospel of Jesus?
- What is your ministry outreach temperature?
- What are you doing to raise your personal or ministry outreach temperature by one degree?
- Tell one outreach story from your personal outreach or ministry area.

Outreach Learning

Teaching Themes: Love of God, the lost, and the church.

Discussion:

- What struck you about the foundational importance of loving God when you read chapter 1 of *OOC*? What can you do to grow your relationship with God and to love Him more?
- What hit you when you read chapter 2 of *OOC* and how are you doing at growing a heart of love for lost people? What can you do to ignite your heart and love for those who are far from God?
- Why is it essential that we love the local church (including the church we attend)? How can you grow your love for your church?

Ministry Strategy: Influencing my Level 4 Leaders

Present your plan for training, encouraging, and keeping your Level 4 Leaders infused with outreach passion, learning, and accountability. Discuss this plan with your OIT leader and refine it. Then, put it into practice starting this month.

Note: You can give all of your Level 4 leaders the link to the online agendas you use for their meetings and they can adapt these for their teams as they see fit.

- Hearts that love God, the lost, and the church with growing passion.
- Your Level 4 Leaders to get the vision and begin living and leading Organic Outreach.
- Your own life to be engaged in outreach and sharing the good news of Jesus.

- What are other doctrines that are core and essential as we follow Jesus and reach out to others?
- Why is doctrine important for a church and believers if we are going to stay focused on the Great Commission?
